5	Provision of parking around local shopping areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify locations of local shopping areas. • Identify location of any existing on and off street disabled parking provision. • Identify ownership of off street car parks (where possible) • Assess whether provision is adequate and in most convenient location. • Seek co-operation of private shopping parade management in reviewing their disabled parking off-street provision. • Assess whether more on-street disabled parking provision can be made. • If more provision is possible, process a Traffic Order to introduce further spaces.
6	Provision of parking around post offices	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify locations of post offices. • Identify location of any existing on and off
