## <u>PURPOSE</u>

1. The purpose of this report is to refer to the Council the recommendation of the Executive in relation to Trust status for leisure facilities.

## **RECOMMENDATION(S)**

2. The Council is recommended to allocate up to £100,000 from the Invest to Save budget in order to pay for specialist help, as necessary, in connection with the Trust status for leisure facilities process.

## <u>REPORT</u>

- 3. At it's meeting held on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2004, the Executive considered a report of the Head of Leisure, Libraries and Culture regarding Trust status for leisure facilities.
- 4. An initial sum of up to £100,000 was requested, funded from the Invest to Save budget, in order to fund the specialist assistance and additional work involved with the process. Significant financial input will be required from both departmental and corporate finance, and external specialist financial advice will be necessary to prepare the business plan.
- 5. The Executive decided:-
