PURPOSE

1. The purpose of this report is to enable the Licensing Panel to determine an application received from BP Express Shopping Ltd, Witan Gate House, 500-600 Witan Gate, Milton Keynes for the grant of a Late Night Refreshment House Licence for the premises known as Mount Pleasant Connect, Mount Pleasant Road, Luton.

RECOMMENDATION

2. That the Licensing Panel determine the application by BP Express Shopping Ltd for the grant of a Late Night Refreshment House Licence for the premises known as Mount Pleasant Connect, which is part of the BP petrol station, Mount Pleasant Road, Luton.

BACKGROUND

3. The Licensing Panel will be aware that the Late Night Refreshment Houses Act, 1969 enables the Council to impose conditions upon the grant or renewal of Late Night Refreshment House Licences. The Council may only impose conditions on the opening hours between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. provided it is satisfied that such conditions are desirable to avoid unreasonable disturbance to neighbouring residents.

- 4. The Council may not refuse to grant or renew a Licence if the prescribed fee is paid. The Council may impose conditions restricting the opening hours and for which there is a right of appeal to the Magistrates Court.
- 5. The following application has been received by the Licensing Unit for consideration by the Licensing Panel:-

- 9. The Environmental Health Manager (Pollution Control) by e-mail dated 27 November 2003 states that there are no current noise complaints relating to the premises and therefore have no comments to make.
