## **PURPOSE**

1. To update members of the Forum on Luton Carnival 2008 and to present the income and expenditure figures for Luton Carnival 2007.

## **RECOMMENDATION(S)**

2. Race Advisory Forum Committee is recommended to note the report.

#### **BACKGROUND**

3. At its meeting of 4<sup>th</sup> June 2007, the Race Advisory Forum resolved (Minute RAF/20/07):

- (ii) The Chair requested that the Arts Development Manager submit a report on a quarterly basis on the Luton Carnival to the Forum.
- 4. At its meeting on 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2007, the Race Advisory Forum requested a report on the income and expenditure for the 2007 Carnival be presented to the 5<sup>th</sup> February 2008 meeting (Minute RAF/42/07). The income and expenditure figures had previously been circulated to Members of the Forum but Members had not previously the opportunity to discuss these figures.

#### ARRANGEMENTS FOR LUTON INTERNATIONAL CARNIVAL 2008

## 5. Consultation / Visioning Group

A number of meetings have taken place with a range of community stakeholders with an interest in carnival. These stakeholders have included Carnival organisations and the UK Centre for Carnival Arts, Luton Sounds Forum, ACCDF, the Carnival Matters group, Bedfordshire Police and other organisations and individuals. Their input has been sought to influence the planning for this year's event. This process has proved to be very satisfactory for all parties. The group will continue to meet throughout the year.

#### 6. Date and time of Event

Bank Holiday, Monday 26th May 2008, 12noon – 7.00pm

#### 7. Carnival Parade Route

The Carnival consultation and visioning group have now agreed the existing route as the most feasible route for this year, following the Independent Safety consultants report into route options. Accordingly planning for the parade has now commenced with initial application forms being made available to those groups that wish to take part in the parade.

#### 8. Sound System Sites

We along with the Luton Sounds Forum and Beds Police have now agreed a total of 8 sound system locations, playing differing genres of sounds system music.

#### 9. Performance Stages

We are planning to have 3 performance stages:

- Market Hill will host local rock and indie bands playing on a trailer type stage
- Wardown Park will host Carnival, Festival and World Music performers
- Telford Way Car Park, will host performances from local music projects such as Digital Academy, UK Unsigned, Diversity Arts Incubation Programme etc.

#### 10. Production Management

In January we will finalise our external production management arrangements for the event.

#### 11. License

We aim to submit our Premises License applications by the end of February.

#### 12. Town Centre Developments

A number of physical developments, in the town centre over the next 10 years or so will have a greater or lesser impact on the carnival event. We have therefore met one of the Engineering and Transportation team to ascertain exactly what development is happening when and to gauge the potential impact on the event.

#### **LUTON INTERNATIONAL CARNIVAL 2007**

13. Members of The Race Advisory Forum have requested to see the figures for expenditure and income for the 2007 event. The income and expenditure statement is listed below, for information, however members should note that although the 2007 event was cancelled, on the day, due to adverse weather conditions, most of the expenditure commitments had to be met, due to contractual obligations. There were however some savings, notably from the Bedfordshire Police and other contractors. The cancellation meant that income from sponsorship, advertising could not be realised.
