PURPOSE

BACKGROUND

3. At their meeting held on 11th April 2002 the Environment and Non Executive Functions Scrutiny Committee considered their work programme for 2002-03.

REPORT

4. Following consideration of their work programme for 2002-03 the Environment and Non-Executive Functions Scrutiny Committee agreed to concentrate on the following topics:
 - Transport – traffic congestion, parking and public transport
 - Clean Street
 - Review of the Borough of Luton Local Plan
 - Environmental Impact on Health – to include pollution
 - Large schemes to be kept under review – i.e. Translink, major road schemes such as the inner ring road and the eastern corridor.
5. The Committee also recommended that the Scrutiny Board put a procedure in place to allow all four scrutiny Committees to track the decisions of the Executive.
6. They further resolved to submit the Annual Report for 2001-02 to the Scrutiny Board.
