Please find attached an open letter to you asking that you urgently look into the parking scheme that has been imposed on the residents of Erin Close and Erin Court.

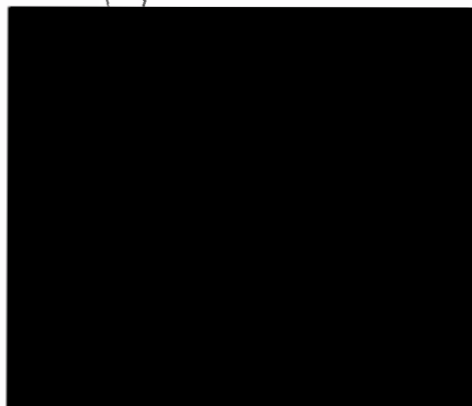

Surely parking away from the town centre is something the Council should be supporting, as it keeps vehicles away from congested areas.

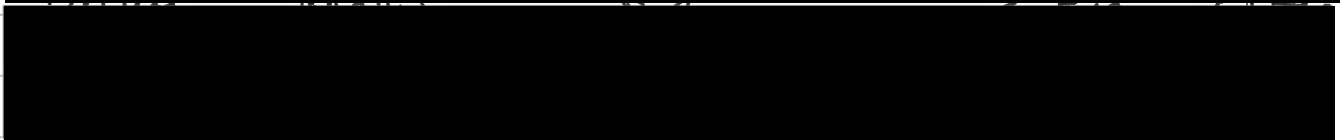
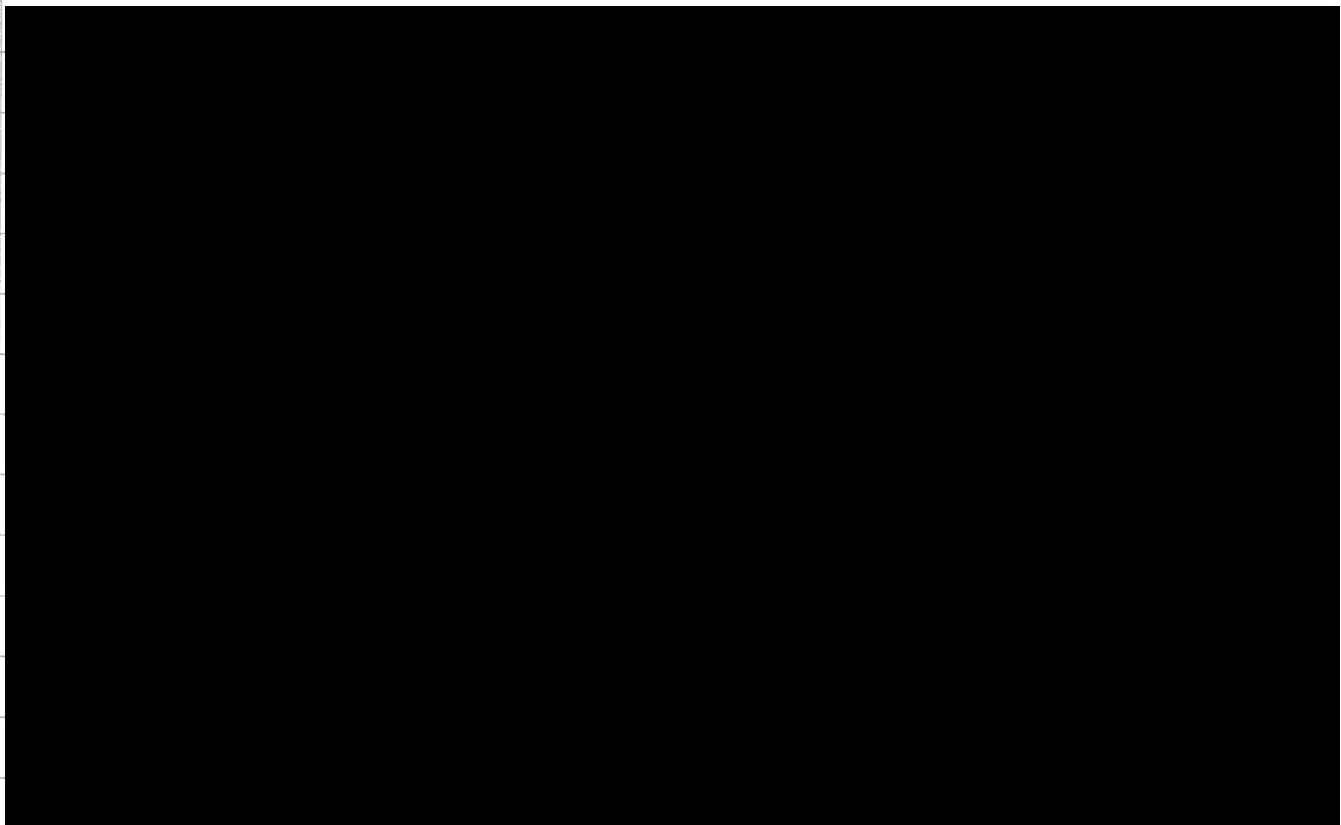
