Will be sold at Columbia country at the Columbia Mines 14 miles north of Thomson on Tuesday March 5th 1833 at 1:00pm.

All slaves are fit and hygienic. Doing either house or field work. There are 20 young Negro boys and girls who are experienced with both indoors and outside work joined with 60 well-built men for meadow work as well as 20 women accustomed to all kinds of house work with excellent cooking and ironing.

Each and every one has outstanding manners and are well and in good physical shape all moneys worth.
