PURPOSE

1. To inform members of the result of the consultation in Sundon Park in regard to the Library Opening Hours.

RECOMMENDATION(S)

2. Bramingham & Sundon Park Area Committee is recommended to note the results.

BACKGROUND

- 3. The Area Committee requested that the opening hours at Sundon Park were reviewed. No increase was possible, so customers and non-users were asked if they wanted to change the opening hours or whether existing hours were convenient.
- 4. Over 3000 questionnaires were distributed throughout Sundon Park. Details are given in the Appendix, as are details of the responses. 114 replies were received, with the majority, 61% asking that the opening hours stay as they are. 41% of respondents also requested that the late opening remain as Thursday. It is therefore suggested that opening hours remain as they are until the Council is in a position to increase hours.
