RECOMMENDATION(S)

1. The views of the Forum are sought in relation to proposed changes to the system of allocating Council housing in the town.

REPORT

2. Attached to this report is a paper that has been considered by elected members about proposals to review the system of allocating social housing in the town.

3. In summary the draft proposals are looking:

to move away from the existing points scheme

to introduce a series of priority bands, i.e. homeless, transfer list, medical etc.

allocations from within bands to be undertaken on a date order basis

quotas will be established for the differing priority bands

the quotas would be reviewed annually

to review the residence qualification

to introduce an assessment of people's financial means to meet their own housing needs

Consider introducing an ineligibility criteria for people (or a member of their household) were guilty of unacceptable behaviour.

- 4. A brief presentation will be made to the meeting explaining in more detail how the system could operate, but the purpose of this paper is to seek comments from the forum about issues that should be considered within the new scheme.
- 5. The Consultation is running during the period of May and June. In addition to comments made at the meeting individual written comments would be welcome with regard to proposals direct to the Head of Housing.
