Since that date, the following progress has been made: New pool – The location of the new pool was considered by the Executive on 14 March 2005. A decision was reached to locate the pool on the former Electrolux site at Addington Way. Future management arrangements – A project plan is in place with both Officer and Members working groups established. Handover to Trust is anticipated 1/9/05 Operational management of leisure – New structure in place. Complete New leisure card scheme implemented on 1/4/05 Sports Development Unit new structure fully in place. Parks Sports – transfer of staff to Parks 1/8/04 went ahead. Budgets transferred April 2005 Stockwood Park Golf Course – Golf centre manager in place. Staff are being kept informed of the implications of Trust status. Staff meetings held. Support to voluntary sector – Sports Council now has a new Exec in place and all areas of working practices are being reviewed. New agreements in place by 1/01/05. Community Development	Eric Haldane	The Options Analysis and Improvement Plan was considered by the Executive meeting on 26 April 2004 and Decision No. EX/184/04 was called in and considered by Regeneration and Citizenship Scrutiny Committee on 1 July 2004. A further report was submitted to the Regeneration and Citizenship Scrutiny Committee on 7th October 2004 addressing concerns raised about the level of support the Council would provide in future for the community centres at Limbury and Sundon Park. A Job Description to provide a shared post between Limbury and Sundon Park as authorised by the Council has been prepared and evaluated. The new post will be included in those available for existing staff to apply for under the Council's redeployment procedure. The total number of posts now available to the remaining affected staff within the new structure has increased to ten and the number of staff at risk has reduced to eight.
