

## Consultation Plan for the Health and Wellbeing Strategy

During June / July formal consultation will be undertaken on the strategy using a mix of methods to enable a wide range of stakeholders to be involved in the process. The aim of the strategy is to provide a clear steer for commissioners to ensure that they plan and commission services which meet the needs of the local population as identified in the Joint Strategic Needs Assessment. The strategy highlights a new approach and the priorities that commissioners will need to take into account when developing their strategies and plans to improve health and wellbeing in Luton. The consultation will provide an opportunity for stakeholders to comment on the approach and the commissioning priorities.
