 - (18) Integration of care package post-discharge;
 - (19) Capacity of community service to support acute care at home;
 - (20) Quality Assurance and performance monitoring procedures.
- HDRG is requested to consider and agree the areas for examination and decide on its approach to evidence gathering, including allocation of tasks to Members relating to the areas identified, as appropriate.
