I am writing to you with regards to the application to grant KFC, Wigmore, Luton the license to remain open till 0200. Your reference number is LA03/KFC/117321.

Although I have no objection to KFC opening in the Wigmore parade I do however object to the extension on their opening hours from 2300 to 0200. Wigmore Fish doesn't stay open to late hours and the Indian Restuarant closes at similar times. The concern would be this sets a president to the other food outlets and public house to apply for extensions.

Traditionally if you look at fast food restaurants set in retail parks, it attracts the attention of "boy racers" and this causes me concerns from an increased noise of vehicles, loud car stereos and the anti-social behaviour from the people in said vehicles.

This sort of behavior then attracts further anti-social behaviour and disorder from youths, and a further increase in the volume of people talking/shouting, possibly drinking in the car park which all leads to further nuisances to the public and even criminal damage or worse criminal activity.

Currently the Wigmore Arms P/H generates loud noise from outside in the car park during the opening hours, however the noise goes to reasonable levels after the pub shuts, leaving just Asda 24x7 traffic in the evening.

My house backs on to Wigmore Lane, Luton, directly opposite the Wigmore Arms PH and sometimes when the pub has special events on, it can often keep me and my family awake. So I find it totally unacceptable that KFC be granted an application to stay open until 0200 in a prodominately residential area.
