- Raynham Way Centre's Programme continues to improve and the staff are now looking to include a Homework Club to run 2 hours after school twice a week. Volunteer Teachers in training will come in and help the children with their homework. The interest in this has been very positive so far.
 Also Football coaching for boys and girls between the ages of 6-11yrs will be held during April – July, with fully qualified Football Coaches, again this had drawn a lot of interest.
